

What is the futurity?

Futurity programs were set up as a way for owners to invest in their horse's future. From weanlings through age 3, owners pay an annual fee (between \$30 and \$100) for each horse they want enrolled in the futurity that year. In return, the horse may show at the AHR Futurity Show that same year, having a chance at winning back more money than was invested..

Who can participate?

Any AHR registered weanling may enroll in the AHR Futurity. AHR registered yearlings, two and three-year-olds who were signed up the year before may also re-enroll.

When do I need to enroll?

Weanlings should enroll by Dec. 31st of the year they are born. They may enroll until 6/15 of their yearling year, but at twice the enrollment fee. Previously enrolled yearlings, two and three-year-olds must re-enroll by June 15th each year they wish to remain eligible.

Why should I enroll my horse?

Cash! Also, some buyers prefer to purchase futurity enrolled horses.

If I enroll in the futurity this year, am I obligated to re-enroll next year?

No. But, if your horse is not re-enrolled the following year, it cannot re-enroll again later. You must enroll your horse every year to remain eligible to participate in the AHR Futurity Show and program each year.

I just purchased a new Haflinger. How do I know if it was enrolled previously in the AHR Futurity?

If you are a new owner of a weanling, yearling, two or three-year-old, contact the Futurity Co-Chairs immediately and they will let you know if the horse was enrolled previously. Deadlines are important. Don't wait to find out whether your horse qualifies! Waiting could cause your horse to be ineligible!

What is the S.I.P.?

The S.I.P. (Stallion Incentive Program) is a free, weanling halter class held at the AHR Futurity Show and is funded by S.I.P. stallion owners. All weanlings who are enrolled in the futurity are also eligible to participate in the S.I.P. class if they are sired by a S.I.P. stallion and the owners sign up for the S.I.P. class on the enrollment form. A list of S.I.P. stallions can be found in the AHR "Haflinger Horse" magazine each year. As with the regular futurity class, there are substantial paybacks in the S.I.P. class as well.

I don't show. Can someone else show my horse for me at the futurity show?

Yes! Handlers do not need to be owners.

How do I enroll my horse in the AHR Futurity? Use the form on the reverse side and mail with your check asap!
