



## American Haflinger Registry Out West Inspection Survey



Quite a few members of AHR have requested inspections out west for a number of years. In the past, we have tried to solicit people to organize these inspections, but have had trouble finding people, and have not had enough horses in place to do so.

In order to make an inspection out west happen, there would need to be a minimum of ten horses. Given that the states and distance out west for people to travel are spread very far apart, there is a possibility to have two different sites out west in two different states if there are enough horses at both sites.
